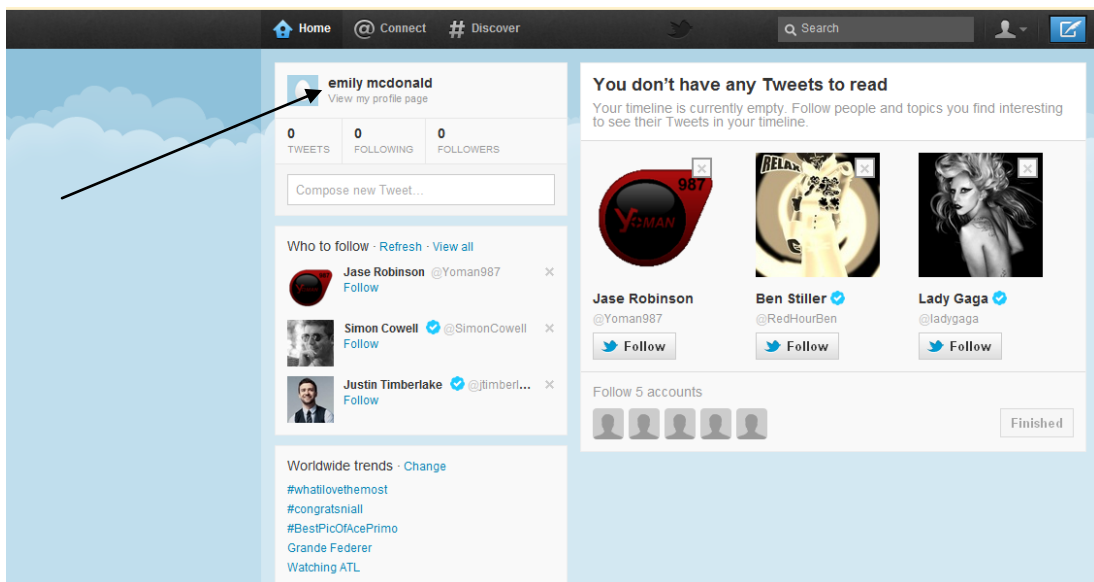


How to Use Twitter:

Having trouble with Twitter, that's okay it will take some time to get used to it.

Upload a photo of yourself: It will allow people who are looking for you recognize that it is your account

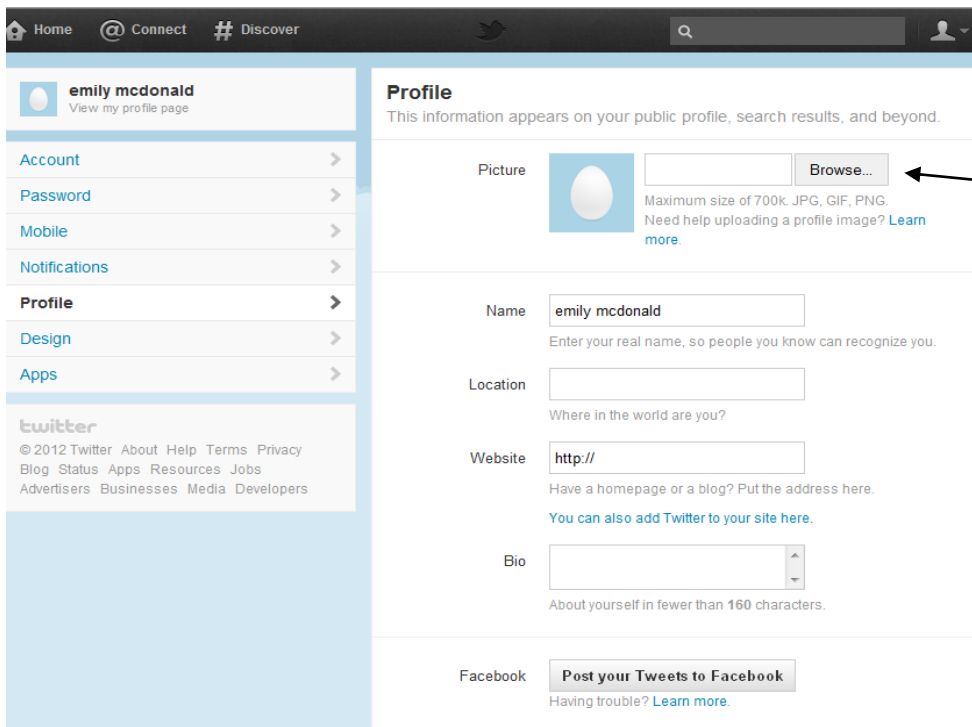
1. Sign into your Twitter account



2. Click on your name that is next to the blue and white egg symbol.
3. This page will then load



4. Then click on the 'Edit your profile' button on the right side of the screen.
5. This will be the next page you see.

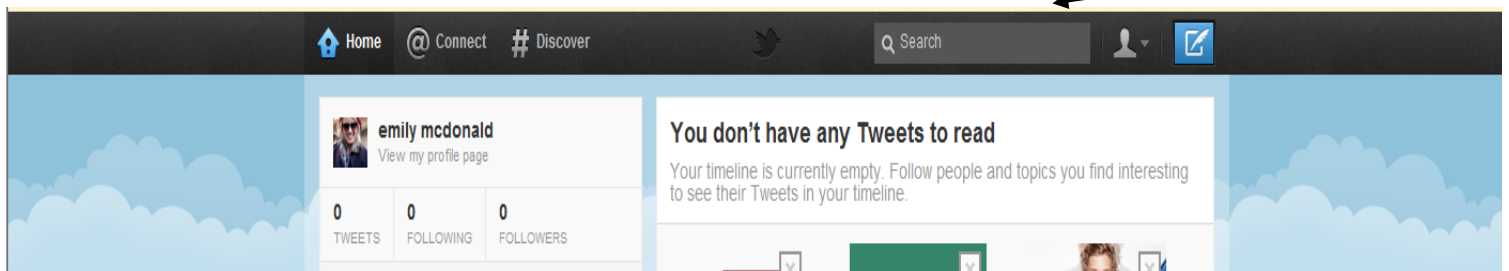


6. Click on the 'browse' button next to the picture of the blue and white egg.
7. Your Computer documents will then appear. Find your photo by selecting the file and name it is under on your computer.
8. Double click the photo and the page will disappear.
9. Click on the blue 'Save Changes' button on the bottom of the page.
10. Your photo will then be uploaded and saved to your profile.

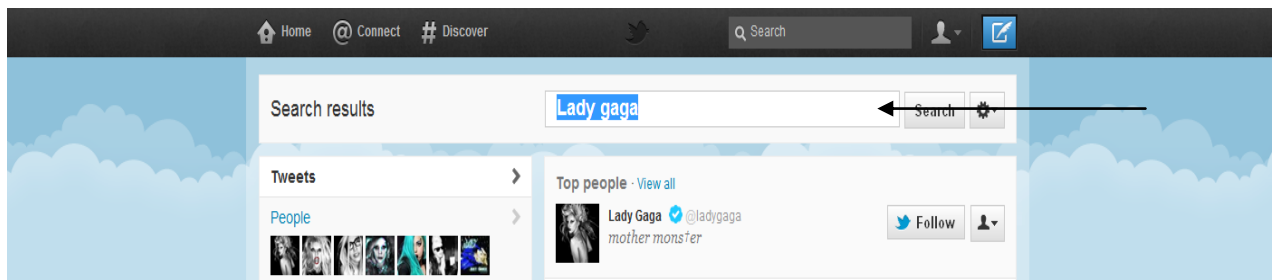
How to find things to follow:

If you didn't find any followers when you created the account, do it now and get the latest gossip from your favourite celebrities and news or follow your family and friends.

1. On your Twitter Account page, click on the 'Search' toolbar on the right side of the page.



2. Type in the person or company you are looking for and press 'Enter' on your keyboard.
3. This page will then load with the person you are looking for.



4. If you choose to follow this person, click on the 'Follow' button on the right side of the users display picture.



5. This icon will then change to

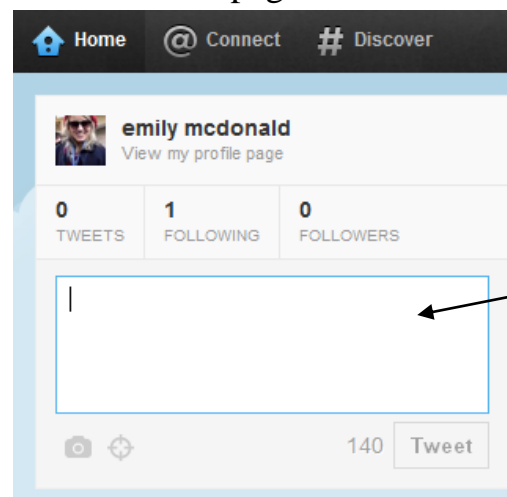

How to Tweet.

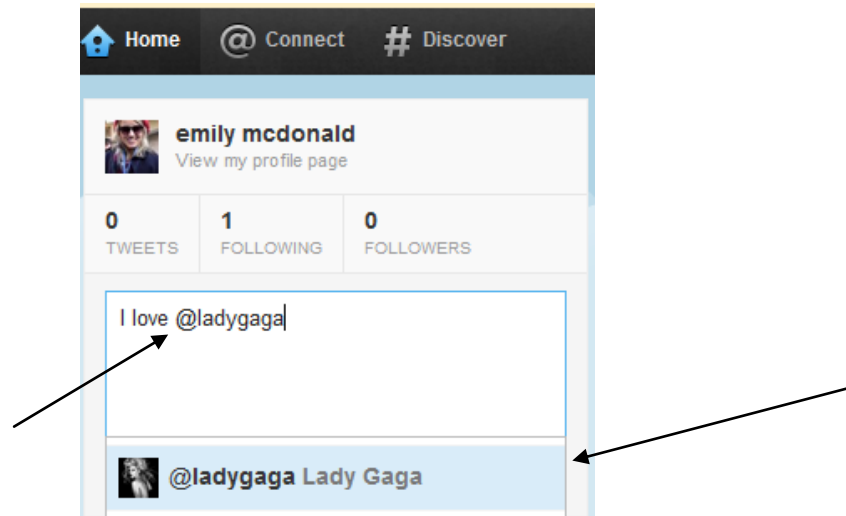
Tweeting is how you communicate with your followers, they may then choose to retweet what you have to say by expressing your thoughts.

1. On your Twitter Account page click on the 'Compose New Tweet' button.



2. Type in what you have to say.

3. If you want to link it to a person add the @ (shift + 2) symbol before typing in the name of the person and click on the blue link under the white box.



4. If you want to link it to something you want your followers to discover then add the # (shift + 3) symbol before typing in what you want them to discover or look at.



5. And Press the Blue 'Tweet' button.

You have now made your first Tweet.

How to create an Event.

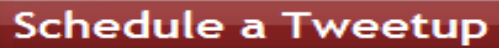
1. To create an event on Twitter, you will need to open up a Web Browser page on either Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox.
2. On the toolbar, Type in: twtvite.com and press 'Enter' on the keyboard.



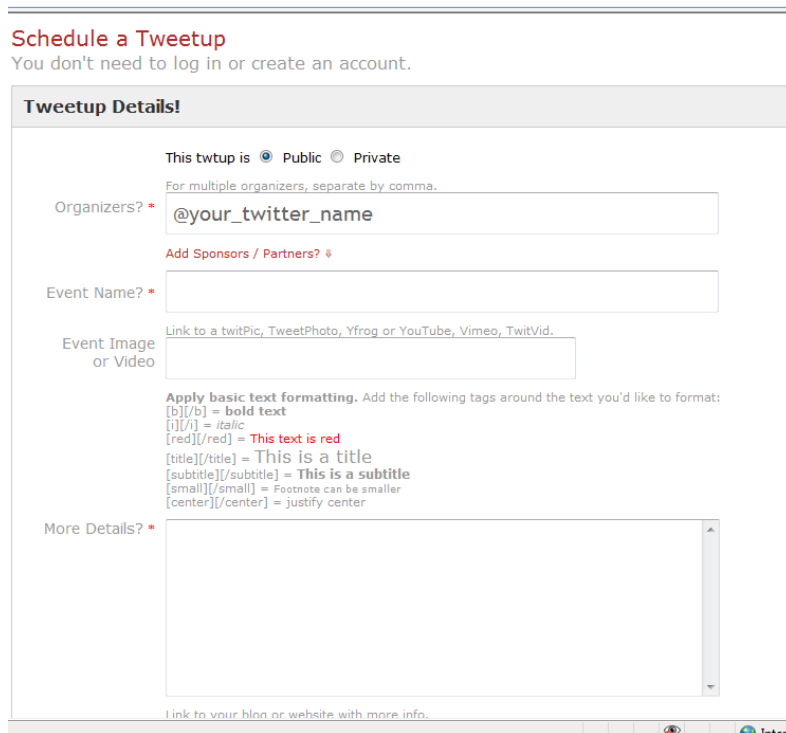
3. This page will then load.



4. Click on the 'Schedule a Tweetup' button.



5. The Schedule a Tweetup page will then load.



6. Follow the prompts firstly by selecting whether you want the event private or not and then add your twitter username to the organizers so that people can find out more about the event through your Twitter account.

 [small]/[small] = Footnote can be smaller
 [center]/[center] = justify center

7. Scroll down the page and give the event a date, time and place.

8. Place a hash tag (#) before the event name. This allows Twitter users to spread the event and their opinion about it.
